

*Workplace Safety for the ESL Learner: Designing Small Group Workshops*

**Abstract:** Workplace safety can be of particular interest as an ESL topic as language barriers can create potentially hazardous situations. This workshop will address how to evaluate students' needs, determine appropriate content, and design effective and engaging ESL activities. Additionally, this workshop will review existing, adaptable materials and present a sample activity.
